Board Policy Administrative Policy Procedure Guideline

When the president is temporarily absent from campus or incapacitated, the responsibility to function as the chief executive officer of the university passes through the chain of command as follows, subject to the presence on campus of the officer next in line as well as that officer's ability to serve: executive vice president/provost; vice president for finance and administrative services; vice president for development; vice president for government relations; vice provost for academic affairs; vice provost for academic administration.

If the president issues a written order establishing a different chain of command for certain situations, that written order prevails over this Executive Order.

Central Michigan University reserves the right to make exceptions to, modify or eliminate this policy. This document supersedes all previous policies, procedures and directives relative to this subject.
