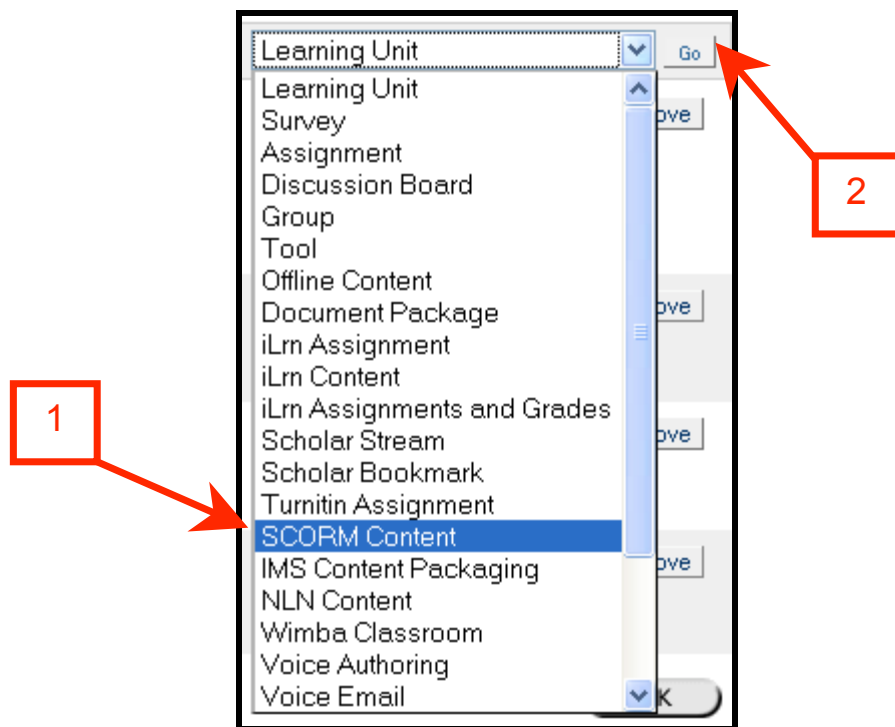


SCORM (Sharable Content Objective Reference Model) is a standard for educational content delivered through an e-Learning platform. Blackboard supports SCORM compliant objects up to version 1.2. It also supports SCORM2004.

1. From the **Control Panel**, click on a content area in which the SCORM content is to appear.
2. From the dropdown menu in the upper right-hand corner, select **SCROM Content** and click **GO**.



3. Enter the name of the item and then browse to the location of the package on your computer or network.

4. Change options for **Navigation Control Type** as needed.
  - a. Choose **Flow** if the object takes the user from one part to the next.

- b. Or choose **Choice** to show a map of different parts of the object which the user may navigate themselves.
5. Change settings for **Gradebook Options** as needed.
  - a. **Add Gradebook Item-** Select Yes to add a column in the Grade Center for this content item.
  - b. **Track Attempt Details-** Select Yes to be able to view user interaction with the content, such as viewing time and question responses.
  - c. **Points Possible-** Enter the points possible for the item. If nothing is entered, the item will be given 0 points possible. This can be modified at a later date through the “Modify Column” option in the Grade Center.
  - d. **First Attempt Only-** If Yes is selected, attempt detail will only display for the first time the user accesses the content.
6. Select the **Content Options** according to desired preferences.
7. Click **Submit**.
