**SUBJECT: AUTHORIZATION TO SUBMIT UNIVERSITY TO
JURISDICTION OF COURTS OF OTHER STATES**

1. The Institute for Personal and Career Development which is a division of Central Michigan University does business in several states.
2. From time to time, the University is requested to register in another state as a foreign corporation.
3. Such registration is often inappropriate inasmuch as Central Michigan University is a constitutional entity under the constitution of the State of Michigan and is not a foreign corporation in the traditional sense.
4. As an alternative, some states request that the University agree to submit to the jurisdiction of the courts of that state with regard to matters arising out of the University's operations in that state.

Therefore, the President is authorized on behalf of the Board of Trustees to submit the University to the jurisdiction of the courts of other states of the United States with regard to any matters arising out of Central Michigan University's operations in those states.
