SUBJECT: FREEDOM OF INFORMATION POLICY*

The president is authorized to make and publish reasonable rules and procedures to implement the Michigan Freedom of Information Act, including rules in connection with fees charged for services under the Act.

The president or his designee is authorized to accept and act upon appeals from final denials of requests for records, consistent with subsection 10(2) of the Freedom of Information Act.

The Freedom of Information Policy adopted by the Board of Trustees on April 20, 1977, is rescinded.
