Looking to earn a Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree? Check out CMU's online RN-to-BSN completion program! If you have already achieved RN status through an associate's degree program, enrolling in our RN-to-BSN program is the next logical step in your career. While you can work as a RN with an associate's degree, nurses with a BSN are typically given more responsibility, supervisory roles, and higher salaries. The good news is the RN-to-BSN program can be completed while you continue working as a nurse, which means you will advance your career without having to take time off.

Program Requirements

At CMU, students must satisfy both the nursing major curriculum and the CMU general education program requirements. The nursing degree requires 120 semester credit hours of which 90 credit hours can be transferred into this program.

Transfer Guides and Articulation Agreements

You can review the [transfer guides and articulation agreements](#) from the Community College or University you attended to see how your credits will transfer to CMU.

NEW College Transfer Guidelines - If one of the below requirements are met, you will have satisfied the University Program portion of the general education requirements at CMU.

1. Student has satisfied the State of Michigan MACRO or MTA Agreement.
2. Student has satisfied a statewide transfer agreement.
3. Student has completed an Associate of Arts or an Associate of Science degree.
4. Student has completed an associate degree in applied or professional discipline. Disciplines must be germane to a program at CMU (ADN nurses qualify here).

All other students may refer to the General Education Requirements section of the Undergraduate Bulletin for guidelines on the applicability of their transfer credit toward University Program requirements.

General Education Requirements (30-42 hours)

Note: Most requirements may be met while earning your Associate in Nursing.

- University Program Courses (27 hours) - This section of CMU's General Education introduces students to the major fields of human knowledge including coursework in the humanities, natural and social sciences, as well as topics related to diversity and multicultural perspectives. RN-to-BSN applicants with an associate's degree or higher will have this section fulfilled.
- Competency courses (12-15 hours)
 - English Composition (two courses): ENG 101 & 201
 - Oral English or Oral Communications: COM 101
 - Mathematics: at least MTH 105 or above, excluding MTH 151 & 152
 - Quantitative Reasoning (statistics course will fulfill this requirement for most students): STA 282QR
