4. STUDIO & GRAPHIC DESIGN ART MAJORS: Portfolio: 8-10 images/examples of your creative work. Please create a single PDF with all images and submit via USB drive. Detail prints of large pieces may be included at the applicant’s discretion as well. Detail prints and multiple sculptural prints of the same work are not counted as part of the maximum of 10. Each work must be clearly identified as follows: Title of work / Course that it was completed in (if applicable) / Date of completion / Medium / Dimensions. The student’s name must be on the USB drive.

ART HISTORY MAJORS: 4-5 written assignments in art history: These may include mid-term or final exams, written assignments and research papers. Each example must be clearly identified with the course that it was completed in (if applicable) and date of completion. Please submit assignments as PDF files on a USB drive. The student’s name must be on the USB drive.

ART EDUCATION MAJORS: Portfolio of 4 – 6 images of creative work and 2-3 written assignments: These may include mid-term or final exams, written assignments, research papers, or lesson plans. Each example must be clearly identified with the course that it was completed in (if applicable) and date of completion. Please submit all written assignments and Images/examples of your creative work should be submitted as a single PDF and submit via USB drive. Each work must be clearly identified as follows: Title of work / Course that it was completed in (if applicable) / Date of completion / Medium / Dimensions. The student’s name must be on the USB drive.
