FORENSICS: DEBATE AND INDIVIDUAL EVENTS

GENERAL INFORMATION

The CMU Forensic program has an over 40-year tradition of competing successfully at prestigious events across the nation. Our students have won numerous awards at the National Forensics Association's National Tournament, the National Junior Division Debate Tournament, and the National Debate Tournament, with the team covering lodging, transportation, entry fee and meal expenses. Our Special Talent Scholarship program is part of our ongoing effort to provide top students with growth opportunities beyond the classroom. Each year several students are awarded \$1,000 Special Talent Scholarships, which are distributed to their CMU account in payments of \$500 each semester. On meeting the renewal requirements (see below), awards of \$500 continue each fall and spring semester to a maximum award of \$4,000.

SELECTION PROCESS

Scholarships winners will be primarily determined through consideration of your previous debate experience and the information provided through the two mandatory recommendations detailed below.

SUBMISSION PROCESS AND DEADLINE

Students must submit this completed application form and two letters of recommendation – one from a person who can assess your academic ability and a second from a person who can evaluate your talent as a potential competitor in college forensics. RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS

In order to renew your scholarship for additional semesters, you must complete and return a renewal form to our office by the end of the last week of classes each semester, and:

1. Carry at least 12 credit hours each semester.
2. Maintain and overall grade point average of 2.5 on a four point system at Central Michigan University.
3. Satisfactorily prepare for and participate in a minimum of three tournaments per semester.
4. Make an earnest effort to implement the suggestions of the coaching staff concerning preparation for competition.
5. Make an earnest effort to attend appropriate tournaments designed by the coaching staff.
6. Assist with events and tournaments sponsored by the Central Michigan University forensics program.
