Study Abroad Scholarships

- **Gary & Cathleen Collins Endowed Scholarship** – For junior or senior students who are seeking an experience in international business. Michigan high school graduate, demonstrate financial need, seeking opportunities for experience through internships or other business educational opportunities. Minimum GPA 3.25. **Must have filed FAFSA and have been APPROVED to receive aid.**
One award - \$1,500

- **Russell and Linda Dippel Family Award** – Study abroad award for a student enrolled in the College of Business Administration, majoring in accounting with a minimum GPA of 3.00. Preference given to students from Eisenhower High School in Shelby Twp., MI. **Scholarship based on financial need. One award - \$600**

- **Dr. Helferich International Humanitarian Program Scholarship in Honor of Dr. Robert L. Cook** – For students who are seeking an international humanitarian/community services experience to enhance their business education and gain experience related to the corporate social responsibility (CSR) challenges. The recipient will be a student enrolled in the College of Business Administration with a minimum GPA of 2.50 on a 4 point scale. Preference for a student with a major or minor in Logistics Management or Purchasing and Supply Management and, who is a member of a service organization such as CMU Rotaract Club or American Red Cross Club. Student must be a minimum of sophomore standing upon receipt of the award. The award may be used to assist with tuition or travel related expenses of a CMU sponsored international study experience – preferably one with a humanitarian/community service focus. **One award - \$500**

- **Global Intercultural Development Experience (GIDE)** – Study abroad award for students enrolled in the College of Business Administration, BIS 342 course – Intercultural Business Communication (or its future equivalent). Student will have a minimum GPA of 2.50.

- **Goodwin Family Award** – Study abroad award for a Junior or Senior student enrolled in the College of Business Administration, majoring in business, with a minimum GPA of 2.80. **Five awards @ \$2,000 each**

- **Journey Fund for Growth** – Study abroad award for students enrolled in the College of Business Administration, BIS 342T course to study abroad in Thailand.

- **The Magnusson Study Abroad Award** – Study abroad award for a student enrolled in the College of Business Administration. **Four awards \$2,500 each**

- **Marble Family Award** – Student must be enrolled in the College of Business Administration with a GPA of 3.00. The award will be used for a study abroad experience. **One award – \$1,200**

Study Abroad Scholarship Information

The College of Business Administration has allocated funds to award scholarships to business students who participate in study abroad programs for a semester, an academic year or summer (three weeks minimum). The scholarships are based upon academic merit or financial need or both. Preference is given to students enrolling in a CMU-approved program.

Minimum Qualifications for Application

1. Be approved to study abroad through CMU.
2. U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
3. Full-time, matriculated, on-campus undergraduate or graduate business student at CMU at the time of application and during the term of study abroad.
4. For undergraduates: minimum 2.7 GPA. For graduates: minimum 3.3 GPA.
5. At the time of study abroad, undergraduates must have at least sophomore standing; graduates must have completed one semester of study.
6. Two letters of reference from faculty (Submitted in a sealed envelope).

Application Deadlines

3rd Friday in October = deadline for students studying abroad spring.

3rd Friday in March = deadline for students studying abroad summer or fall.

Award Announcements

Awards will be announced in November for spring and April for summer and fall.
