

Scholarships for Incoming Business Freshmen

CENTRAL MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY College of Business Administration

- **Arthur Andersen Endowed Fund in Accounting:** (typical award of up to \$1,800 per student)
Qualifying recipients will be incoming freshmen in the College of Business Administration, intending to earn an Accounting major in the School of Accounting, with a minimum GPA of 3.50 and a composite ACT of no less than 25. Students must submit an application and essay which focuses on why they are interested in pursuing a career in accounting, as well as their involvement in school and community activities. Recipients are expected to join the Students Accounting society (SAS) and participate in a mentoring program provided by SAS or Beta Alpha Psi (BAP), an honorary financial information organization. The scholarship is renewable with the maintenance of a 3.25 overall GPA. Qualifying students may receive the award for up to eight semesters if they continue to meet the qualifications established by the fund, including full-time continuous enrollment.

- ****Jerry & Felicia Campbell Scholarship:** (typical award of up to \$12,000 - \$20,000 over 4 years)
Student must be an incoming freshman who has taken part in the Centralis Competition and intends to pursue a degree in business with a minimum GPA of 3.50 and a composite ACT of at least 28. Finalists will participate in a phone interview in April. Student must live in the Business Residential College in Trout Hall during his/her first year at CMU. Scholarship is renewable with the maintenance of a 3.25 GPA and satisfactory academic progress.

- **Rob & Liz Haar Cornerstone Endowed Scholarship:** (typical award of up to \$1,000 per student)
Student must be an incoming freshman who intends to pursue a degree in business with an interest in pursuing a major in information systems. Student must have a minimum GPA of 3.00. First preference will be given to graduates of Cornerstone Schools in Detroit. While this award is renewable, it is not automatic. Students must reapply for renewal.

- **Fredrick & Rosemary Kreft Endowed Scholarship:** (typical award of up to \$2,500 per student)
Qualifying recipients will be incoming freshmen in the College of Business Administration, intending to earn an Accounting major School of Accounting, with a minimum 3.5 GPA and a composite ACT score of at least 24. First preference given to students who are residents in the following counties: Emmet, Cheboygan, Presque Isle, Charlevoix, Antrim, Otsego, Montmorency, Alpena, Leelanau, Benzie, Grand Traverse, Kalkaska, Crawford, Oscoda, Alcona, Manistee, Wexford, Missaukee, Roscommon, Ogemaw, or Iosco. The scholarship is renewable with the maintenance of a 3.25 overall GPA. This scholarship can be used in addition to the scholarship package of a student qualifying for a Board of Trustees Scholarship.

- ****Kirk H. Love Scholarship:** (typical award of up to \$1,500)
Student must be an in-coming freshman majoring in Finance and/or Personal Financial Planning with a minimum GPA of 3.50. Centralis Competition and essay required. The scholarship is renewable with the maintenance of a 3.25 overall GPA. **Scholarship is based on financial need.**

- **Gene & Melissa McKay Endowed Scholarship:** (typical award of up to \$2,500) Student will be an incoming freshman or transfer student pursuing a degree in business with a 3.00 overall GPA. **Scholarship is based on financial need.**

- **Scott L. Pranger Central Michigan University Business Scholarship:** (typical award of full cost of attendance \$22,500 for 4 years)
Student must be an in-coming freshman from Shelby High School or Spring Lake High School majoring in the College of Business Administration. Qualified recipients will have a minimum H.S. GPA of 3.5 and demonstrate financial need. Preference will be given to students who participated in a high school team sport. However, an applicant may not receive the award, if they have received an athletic scholarship from CMU. Scholarship is renewable up to 4 years of enrollment at CMU, as long as the recipient maintains a minimum 3.3 GPA freshman year and a 3.5 GPA through the senior year. Recipients must remain full-time and pursuing a business degree or the scholarship is not renewed.

- **Jerry & Glad Scoby Endowed Scholarship:** (typical award of up to \$500) Student must be enrolled in the College of Business Administration. Qualified recipients will have a minimum GPA of 3.00 and demonstrate financial need. Preference will be given to students who are from Beaverton, Michigan schools. Scholarship may be renewed for up to three years. The amount of the award may vary and are contingent upon availability of funds.

**Eligibility for the Centralis Honors Scholarship Competition requires a 3.7 GPA and ACT of 27 or higher. The above CBA scholarships can be combined with a maximum of 2 CMU merit-based scholarships per academic year.

Students who accept the Centralis Award may not be eligible to receive the Campbell or Love Scholarships.
