



Outstanding Thesis, Doctoral Project, Dissertation, and Plan B Award Nomination

PURPOSE The Outstanding Thesis, Doctoral Project, Dissertation, and Plan B Award was established to recognize scholarly activity by graduate students and the contribution made by their faculty supervisors.

AWARDS A maximum of eight awards will be made during the fall semester by the Dean of the College of Graduate Studies. Bookplates recognizing the award are placed in the student's copies of the document. In addition, a certificate is presented to the student as well as a \$250 award.

ELIGIBILITY Theses, Doctoral Projects, Dissertations, or Plan B papers completed during the 12 months prior to the nomination time and nominated by a faculty member are considered.

PROCEDURES Faculty members should complete this form and attach the completed thesis, doctoral project, dissertation, or Plan B paper (if it is not available through the Libraries Digital Collections). A committee evaluates the nominations and makes recommendations to the Dean of the College of Graduate Studies.

DEADLINE Nominations are due by 5:00 p.m. on the second Friday of October in the College of Graduate Studies at the address below. Recipients of the awards will be notified by the end of the fall semester.
