Former U.S. Representative Bart Stupak is a partner in the Legislative and Government Affairs group at the law firm Venable LLP. He represented Michigan’s First Congressional District (northern Michigan) from 1993 to 2011.

In Congress, he served on the Energy and Commerce Committee and as Chairman of the Oversight and Investigations Subcommittee. In this role, Mr. Stupak helped lead investigations into key issues, such as physical and cyber security breaches at U.S. nuclear labs, food and drug safety, and insurance company rescissions of insurance policies.

In 2010 he played an important role in passing the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (health care reform act) while also facing death threats and political backlash.
