*Perro Bomba* illustrates the plight of Haitian immigrants living a challenging but stable life in Santiago, some without papers nor knowledge of Spanish. It provides a dramatically rich depiction of Haitian Creole culture in the Hispanic setting of distant Chile, which, like the U.S. and other parts of the world, is affected by forced migration, socio-economic tensions and racism, but is also a place of empathy and deep human affection.
