

Wasaburo Fujimiya Study Abroad Scholarship

Mr. Fujimiya is a CMU alumnus and representative director of Huggle Electronics, Inc. in Japan and Korea. Mr. Fujimiya wishes to support CMU students pursuing their education overseas and international students studying at CMU.

An award up to \$1,500 will be distributed up to twice a year to a student enrolled in the College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences or a program under the School of Public Service and Global Citizenship. This award is not renewable. Preference will be given to students with financial need as determined by the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid.

Funding Criteria:

- Undergraduate or graduate student with a 3.0 GPA or higher who chooses to study in one of CMU's Japanese or East Asian exchange partner program universities, and/or students from one of these exchange program universities studying at CMU
- Approved through the Office of International Affairs/Study Abroad.
- Enrolled full-time at the time of the award and during the term of the study abroad
- CMU students should demonstrate financial need by filing Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.ed.gov. (For additional FAFSA information, please contact the [Student Service Court](#).)

Henry & Nancy Fulton Annual Scholarship

Dr. Henry L. and Reverend Nancy Fulton are long-time supporters of CMU. Nancy Fulton is a CMU alumna who majored in English. Dr. Henry Fulton is an emeritus faculty member of the English department.

The award amount varies. Awards will support undergraduate and graduate students who will participate in a minimum of one semester (summer study not included) at one of the following universities located in Scotland:

University of Aberdeen	University of Glasgow	University of Strathclyde
University of Edinburgh	University of St. Andrews	University of Sterling

Funding Criteria:

- Full time undergraduate or graduate student with a 3.0 GPA or higher who is planning to spend a full semester studying abroad (not including summer study)
- Recipients will be required to enroll at the Scottish university in at least one course per term in Scottish literature, history, art history, politics, philosophy, sociology, anthropology, or folklore
- Approved through the Office of International Education

Delphine E. Rogers Study Abroad Award

Mrs. Rogers is a CMU alumni and graduate of Central Michigan University, Delphine taught students in Michigan and New Hampshire, retiring from the Gaylord Public School District in 1999. Mrs. Rogers wishes to support CMU students pursuing their education overseas in appreciation of the transformational experience of travel.

The award amount varies, and will be distributed annually to a student enrolled in the College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences. This award is not renewable. Preference will be given to students studying to be teachers, and those with financial need as determined by the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid.

Funding Criteria:

- Junior or Senior with a 3.0 GPA or higher who chooses to study in a major within the College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences. Preference given to students studying to be teachers.
- Applicants should demonstrate financial need by filing a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.ed.gov. (For additional FAFSA information, please contact the [Student Service Court](#).)

Martin Steinbis and Friends Study Abroad Award

The Martin Steinbis and Friends Study Abroad Award is open to interdisciplinary students affiliated with programs, projects and/or courses in the School of Public Service and Global Citizenship with preference given to students minoring in Sustainability, Environmental Policy or Neuroscience.

Recipients will receive awards of a minimum \$1,000 or the residual of the amount remaining in the Award fund if less than \$1,000.

- Recipient of the award must have a minimum GPA of 3.25 on a 4.0 scale.
- Be involved in a faculty-led study abroad program or semester long study abroad experience at international institutions affiliated with the School of Public Service and Global Citizenship.

Application Process for all Study Abroad Awards:

- Applicants must submit an application form, a current “Unofficial Transcript” from the Registrar’s Office and one letter of recommendation from a CMU faculty member.
- Applicants must submit a one to two page essay providing a brief autobiography and a description of educational goals and professional or career aspirations. A list of study abroad objectives focusing on the educational and professional relevance of the trip will need to be stated clearly in the essay. Please include detailed information regarding any clinical, field, research, or internship opportunities.
- You must provide evidence of the request for support from CMU’s Office of Study Abroad by attaching a copy of your completed *Study Abroad Application Checklist*.
- A committee will review all eligible applications and determine the awards based on information obtained and, when applicable, provided by the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid. Students will receive notification via email approximately 4 - 6 weeks after the deadline.

DEADLINES: **OCTOBER 31** for spring semester travel
MARCH 30 for summer and/or fall semester travel
