

Camp Schedule

Monday

Using computers, magazines, etc. to look at what is happening in fashion and why. Students will compile pictures, fabrics, etc. to create a series of trend boards that will represent what they discovered in regards to current silhouettes, colors, fabrics, trims, details and more. We will introduce Adobe Illustrator and/or Photoshop to the students.

Tuesday

We'll show examples of interesting skirt options and possibilities before they start the drawings. This way they'll know what's possible and they'll have some ideas of what they could do. Students will learn the basics of Fashion Illustration and draw the fashion sketch that they will make.

Wednesday

Students will learn basic patternmaking skills to develop their individual skirt pattern. Student will assist in the developing of this pattern. Students will tie-dye a fashion camp T-shirt and alter it according to their designs.

Thursday

Students will work with FMD students who will assist them to construct the garments. After lunch, they will wear the garments that they made and students will put together a mini portfolio of their work from the week that will be presented at the fashion show for the parents on Friday afternoon.

Friday

Students will assist in setting up the fashion show in the morning and have a run through for the shows. The parents will show up after lunch, have time to look at the portfolios and see a slideshow of their kids and what they did all week and then watch the show.
