

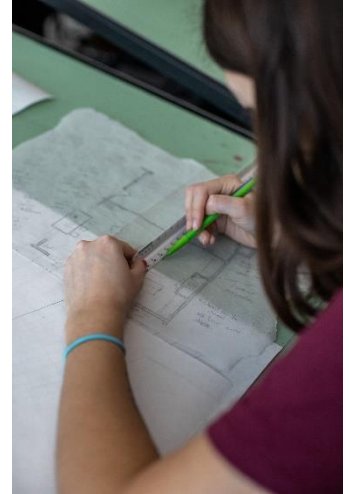
Admission to Interior Design Program

ADMISSION PROCESS

You must apply for admission to the Interior Design program in the semester prior to enrolling in IND 337. Program faculty will enroll you in IND 337 once you are successfully admitted to the program. After you have been enrolled in IND 337, the enrollment system should allow you to enroll in IND 334.



To be admitted to the program:

1. Complete the following IND courses AND receive a grade of C or higher prior to being admitted to the program:
 - a. IND 131
 - b. IND 138
 - c. IND 139
 - d. IND 332WI
 - e. *ART 106 (or equivalent freehand drawing course)
 - f. IND 134/397 OR *ART 231
 - g. *ART 119
 - h. **ART 285

*You have the opportunity to submit a portfolio that demonstrate skills from previous art experiences. To seek a waiver, please see www.ehs.cmich.edu/interiordesign and click on **Portfolio Review** to obtain instructions on how to prepare a Portfolio submission for review. *Portfolio Review may occur at any time throughout the semester.*

**You must also complete ART 285 (Intro to Western Art, Part 2) as part of your art related course competencies. This course is a pre/co-requisite to IND 439.

2. Complete and submit the Interior Design Program Admission Application.
3. Submit a copy of your Academic History in Degree Progress. Please highlight the following:
 - a. ART 106 (or equivalent freehand drawing course)
 - b. IND 134/397 OR ART 231
 - c. ART 119
 - d. IND 131
 - e. IND 138
 - f. IND 139
 - g. IND 332WI
4. Submit a copy of your academic schedule from your EHS Academic Advisor (EHS 421).
5. Submit the Program Admission Checklist with your application materials. Please write the grade you received in each course required for admission on the blank line in the Interior Design Program Admission Checklist.
