### **Human Trafficking Update 2021**

**Theresa Wyatt, PhD, RN, CCM, CFN, CCRE, FACFEI:**

Dr. Theresa Wyatt has been a registered nurse for 36 years with 16 years in the Emergency Department and 5 years as a Forensic Nurse Examiner. She has a Master's in Forensic Nursing from Fitchburg State College and a PhD in Nursing with an emphasis on vulnerable populations. Her research is focused on increasing and improving screening of patients for all forms of violence. Dr. Wyatt works closely with the Mid-Michigan Human Trafficking Task force. She is dedicated to teaching healthcare practitioners about compassionate and caring "trauma informed care" for children and adult victims of human trafficking.

**Course description:** The illegal exploitation of men, women and children is a growing concern. Several studies identify that 68% - 87% of adult sex trafficked women visited a healthcare provider while in captivity. Healthcare providers are in vital position to be leaders in the protection and rescue of this vulnerable population. All health care providers should seek specific training on trauma informed care to screen, educate and provide resources to potential victims and survivors in the recovery process. This presentation provides a review of the types of human trafficking, risk factors, and resources to encourage screening and mentoring of potential victims of human trafficking.

**PODCASTS: *Responding to ACEs: Resources for Resilience*** -- A six-part podcast series featuring thought-provoking insights regarding the science behind adverse childhood experiences (ACEs), trauma and resilience. 


