## **Information for Website posting**

Nominations are being sought for the following School of Engineering and Technology Alumni Awards.

- Engineering Alumni of Distinction
- Engineering-Technologist Alumni of Distinction
- Graduate of Last Decade (GOLD) Award

Nominations are due March 15th of each year.

Eligibility: Eligible nominees must be an alumni of CMU School of Engineering and Technology.

**Engineering and Engineering Technologist of Distinction** nominees must be an alumni of the degree program for the discipline for which they are being selected.

**Graduate of the Last Decade (GOLD)** award nominees must also have graduated after 2010, or be under the age of 40 on January 1, 2020.

## Candidates must:

- Be an alumnus in good standing of the degree program for which they are being awarded;
- Established an outstanding professional record;
- Demonstrated distinguished service to their profession;
- Exhibited an interest in and a dedication to the School and to the University through their time, talent, and/or money; and
- Maintained a personal reputation for outstanding character and citizenship at either the local, state, or national level for a period of time sufficient in length to reflect, without reservation, great credit and honor upon the University, the School, and their profession.

**Nominations**: Nomination forms must be completed in their entirety and signed by the nominator. Forms must be submitted no later than March 15th to Kumar Yelamarthi at kumar.yelamarthi@cmich.edu

- Nomination forms, including attachments, cannot exceed 10 pages. If more than 10 pages are submitted, the nomination will be sent back to the nominator.
- Selected candidates must be available to attend the presentation ceremony at the CMU SET Annual Design Expo on May 1, 2020.
