Computer Science/Information Technology **Independent Study Program**

The Computer Science Department maintains independent study programs for qualified undergraduates and graduates interested in obtaining academic credit for computer science related projects. The project must be of such a nature that its completion adds to the academic growth of the student in computer science.

Undergraduate students may register for CPS 497 or CPS 597
Graduate Students may register for CPS 597 or CPS 697

For each of these courses, a student may earn up to 6 semester hours of credit
(no more than 6 credits may be earned on a single project).

100 hours of independent study equates to one semester hour of academic credit

The independent study project application will need to be completed by the faculty member and the student. Once the paperwork is completed please bring form to office, Pearce 413 for the Chair's approval.

Any other requirements for completion of the project will be determined by the faculty member.

After completion of the project, the faculty member will let the office know the project has been completed and the letter grade the student earned.
