

ISAAC BROCK TO HULL

Head Quarters Sandwich 15th Augt 1812.

Sir

The force at my disposal, authorizes me to require of you the immediate Surrender of Fort Detroit—

It is far from my inclination to join in a war of extermination, but you must be aware that the numerous body of Indians, who have attached themselves to my Troops, will be beyond my Controul the moment the contest commences—You will find me disposed to enter into such conditions, as will satisfy the most scrupulous sense of Honor—Lt Colo McDonell & Major Gregg are fully authorized, to conclude any arrangement, that may lead to stop the unnecessary effusion of blood—
