The Outstanding Graduate Project Award was established to recognize scholarly activity by graduate students and the contribution made by their faculty supervisors

### **Nomination Deadline:**

May 5, 2023

*1 Nomination per Program*

### **Eligibility**

Graduate Students that completed a Plan B Paper, Thesis, Dissertation, or Doctoral Project and graduated in any of the following semesters are eligible to be nominated by their faculty advisor.

- Summer 2022
- Fall 2022
- Spring 2023

### **Nomination Process:**

Faculty advisors should complete the nomination form and attach the Plan B Paper or Doctoral Project. Graduate Studies will pull any thesis or dissertation from the Library's Digital Collections. Nominations require the signature of the department chair or program director. Only two nominations allowed per program.

### **Review & Award Process:**

A committee evaluates the nominations and makes recommendations to the Director of Graduate Studies. Award recipients will receive a \$200 award, a certificate, and an award bookplate to place in the student's copies of the document.
