

**Office of Research and Graduate Studies (ORGS)
President's and Provost's Awards for Undergraduate
Research and Creative Accomplishments 2022 - 23**

These awards are intended to recognize outstanding undergraduate research or creative work, such as research presented at national or international meetings or published in the peer-reviewed literature, juried art exhibitions, etc. Although the faculty mentors play a major role in undergraduate research and creative activities, these awards should recognize contributions made by the students to a project. **Please note that students that are nominated must be enrolled at CMU as an undergraduate student for the spring 2023 semester.**

Provost's Awards

Each of the six academic colleges with undergraduate students can select up to two (2) students to receive the Provost's Award for Undergraduate Research and Creative Accomplishments. Colleges should develop their own criteria and processes to identify these students. The recipients of these awards will receive a cash award (\$250) and a signed, framed certificate. In turn, recipients of the Provost's award will be considered for the President's award. Colleges should submit the names of their awardees to ORGS, together with a brief (1 page) rationale outlining the nature and importance of the student's contribution and accompanied by any supporting material that seems appropriate (e.g., copy of publications or creative work). Please submit these materials, along with the attached Nomination Form to the ORGS mailbox (ORGS@cmich.edu).

President's Awards

The material submitted by the colleges on behalf of the 12 recipients of the Provost's Award for Undergraduate Research and Creative Accomplishments will be evaluated by a selection committee appointed by ORGS. The committee will be charged with selecting up to three students whose work seems especially meritorious to receive the President's Award for Undergraduate Research and Creative Accomplishments (these students will not be recognized with the Provost's award). The recipients of the President's award will receive a cash award (\$500) and a signed, framed certificate.
