

LAB DOOR SIGNS

Lab Door Signs provide valuable hazard, emergency contact, and entry designation information to emergency first responders, FM/OIT/Moving & Delivery workers, and visitors.

All labs with chemical, biological, radiological, or laser hazards **MUST** be registered in the Laboratory Registration Manager system and have a lab door sign posted on the outside. Contact the Office of Laboratory and Field Safety (OLFS) at 989.774.4474 or labfieldsafety@cmich.edu to be added as a first-time registrant. The OLFS will print and post the signs from the information provided by you – the requestor – in Lab Registration Manager.

If you need to update lab information, go into Lab Registration Manager and click on the “Approve Information or Request Changes Here” box on the main page.

There are 3 types of Lab Entry to choose from. The Yield entry must be selected for open beam 3B and 4 laser labs and for radiation labs.

Entry Allowed Without Escort



Entry Allowed with Escort Only



Entry Allowed by appointment Only



Green labs can be key/card accessed by individuals who have completed lab safety awareness training.

Yellow labs can be key/card accessed after coordination with a lab worker from the lab in question who is knowledgeable about hazards in the lab.

Red labs can only be entered by appointment and with escorted access from the lab supervisor or designated lab worker from the particular space. Non-lab workers must be escorted at all times.

Note – Visitors must be escorted in green, yellow, and red labs.
