

CITI Training

Personnel involved in Teaching, Research or Outreach will be directed to The Collaborative Institutional Training Initiative Program ([CITI](#)) and will choose "Animal Care and Use" (ACU) in addition to any other relevant trainings listed.

It is required that you use your CMU Global ID and Password when signing up for CITI to enable single sign on (SSO). This allows for automatic integration of CITI and IRB Manager.

Typically Required IACUC Courses Include:

- Working with the IACUC – All IACUC Research
- Reducing Pain and Distress in Laboratory Mice and Rats – Mice and Rats Research
- Working with Amphibians – Amphibian Research
- Working with Mice in Research – Mice Research
- Working with Rats in Research – Rat Research
- Aseptic Surgery – Mice and Rat Research
- Working with Fish in a Research Setting – Fish Research
- Wildlife Research – Field Study Research
- Post Approval Monitoring (PAM) – Mice and Rat Research

Training must be refreshed at least once approximately every three years. You will receive a reminder email from CITI close to the time that your training module(s) will expire.
