In compliance with the federal *Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974* (FERPA) and Central Michigan University's (CMU) information release policies, Central Michigan University is prohibited from disclosing certain information from your student records to a third party. Such information includes, but is not limited to grades; test scores; tuition and fees assessments; financial aid; and other protected data elements.

You may, at your discretion, grant CMU the permission to release information from your student records to a third party. A separate form is required for each third party to which you wish to grant access. You may revoke or amend your choice at any time by writing to the Registrar.

Expiration of Authorization

This authorization to release information, if granted, will expire after one academic year from the date of this release. Participation is voluntary with no implications to your personal performance in this research activity.
