AMA PRA Change in Credit Calculation for Original Presentations at Live CME Activities

At its recent interim meeting the AMA House of Delegates approved a resolution to allow physicians to claim an amount of *AMA PRA Category 1 Credit*[™] that more accurately reflects the learning associated with preparing and presenting an original presentation at a live *AMA PRA Category 1 Credit*[™] activity. While the credit reflects learning involved in the preparation, the amount of credit is based on presentation time. Physicians may now claim up to four credits per each hour of presentation for eligible activities taking place on or after Jan. 1, 2023. The previous ratio was 2:1.
