CTE Credit Agreement

- Only high schools/career and technical centers on the list of state-approved MDE-CTE locations offering Education programs are considered eligible to participate in this credit agreement. (Education General CIP Code 13.0000)
- Students must complete all designated courses above with the required "B" or above standard outlined in the articulation credit agreement.
- All students shall meet and maintain Central Michigan University admission requirements and must apply to be admitted to CMU within three (3) years of completing the education program.
- Students must be enrolled in classes at CMU to receive credit for EDU 107, HDF 100, and HDF 309. Articulated coursework credits will apply only toward program completion at Central Michigan University and will appear on the student's CMU transcript by course code and credit hours. These courses will be posted to the student's Degree Progress, totaling 9 credit hours, with no grade recorded.
- No tuition and fees will be charged for articulated coursework under this agreement.
- Students who complete an equivalent of EDU 107, HDF 100, and/or HDF 309 at another institution will earn credit through that institution and will not receive CTE credit for those courses.
