



CMU's teacher education program "focuses very heavily on positive relationships with students and the importance of the presence of those in a classroom".




of alumni surveyed felt well or adequately prepared to maintain positive relationships with students




of alumni surveyed felt well or adequately prepared to convey learning goals and objectives clearly
