#### **Description:**

This award was established by Roger Coles who was the former chairperson of the Department of Recreation, Parks and Leisure Services Administration and a department faculty member for 45 years. The award is to recognize a student who exemplifies Roger's passion, for commitment and involvement in the profession of recreation, parks and leisure services.

#### Award:

Three awards, in the amount of **\$3,000.00** each, will be given to undergraduate students majoring in RPL.

#### Eligibility Factors:

- 1. Signed RPL major
- 2. Completion of 15 hours of RPL course work
- 3. 2.75 overall GPA in RPL course work
- 4. Membership in a RPL sponsored student association
- 5. Demonstrated service involvement in community, state, or national organizations

#### **Procedure:**

- 2. All applications that are received by the designated deadline will be evaluated by the faculty review committee to determine eligibility for interviewing.
- 3. Applicants will be notified of the selection process results no sooner than 30 days after the submission deadline.

#### **Criteria Used for Evaluation:**

- 1. Materials must be completed and presented in a professional manner.
- 2. Demonstrated involvement in RPL sponsored student organizations.
- 3. Demonstrated quality in academic performance.
- 4. Demonstrated service-learning efforts at the community, state or national level.
