Sarah K. Grinn, Ph.D., AuD., CCC-A is a tenured Associate Professor in the Doctor of Audiology program at Central Michigan University. She leads clinically translatable research focused on understanding individual susceptibility to peripheral and central noise-induced hearing injury. Funded by the National Institutes of Health, research in the Grinn Hearing Lab aims to prevent recreational and occupational noise-induced hearing loss by developing more accurate risk models for evidence-based auditory safety standards.

The field of audiology was born out of a period of worldwide political unrest. Audiologists should therefore anticipate disruption during periods of political unrest and prepare clinically for the identification and treatment of modern-day acoustic weapon trauma, in addition to preparing the public with relevant hearing protection strategies.
