## **Cultural and Global Studies Student Paper Competition**

The Cultural and Global Studies program will present one award to an undergraduate student for the best paper submitted to the program. Papers must be submitted electronically to class@cmich.edu, by 5:00 PM on May 12, 2023.

## Awards:

- Undergraduate winners will receive \$300 applied to their student account and a certificate acknowledging their award.
- Faculty sponsors of the paper will be given a certificate acknowledging their role.

## Eligibility:

- Must be a current CMU student when award is given.
- Must have a CGL major, minor or certificate to apply.
- Entry must be from an assigned course.
- Must be research-oriented and related to the area of the student's singed CGL certificate.
- Must critically discuss some of the key or central ideas of the field.
- At least 2500 words in length.
- Have a faculty sponsor who is a CGL certificate advisor.

## To submit a paper for consideration for any of these awards:

- Students should submit a completed application form and paper electronically to class@cmich.edu
- Papers co-authored by faculty at this institution or another institution are not eligible.
- Student co-authored papers are not eligible.
- A student may not submit more than one single authored paper.

Judging will be conducted by a committee composed of volunteers from the faculty of the CGL program. The Director of the program will select the committee. The committee will be formed to be representative of the disciplines within the CGL program. The associate dean of the college will be an ex-officio member of this committee.

Papers will be judged on overall quality. The evaluation of the papers will include consideration of the content of the paper, the clarity of the presentation, and, if appropriate, the research methods used.
