The Chippewa Battalion is responsible for ceremonial events on campus, as well as providing a professional color guard for outside entities. The Color Guard is a group of four to Six cadets that present the United States and Michigan and Army (optional) flags at games and ceremonies. Presenting the Colors (flags) is a military tradition dating back to the beginning of our country. When performing a Color Guard, four to six cadets form a line. Cadets on each end carry drill rifles (optional). In contrast, the middle-right cadet carries the United States flag, and the middle-left the Michigan flag. During an event, the Color Guard presents the Colors and rifles to render honors to the national anthem of The United States of America. After the event, the Color Guard ensures the proper retiring of the Colors.
