Requirements:

- A typewritten statement of your professional goals (1-2 pages, double-spaced).
- Major in Anthropology with emphasis on archaeology.
- Must have sophomore, junior, or senior status.
- Two letters of recommendation from faculty that can be sent directly to par@cmich.edu.
- Minimum 3.4 GPA and intend to pursue a graduate degree in Anthropology.

_____ Greg and Antoinette Rickle Endowed Scholarship

Requirements:

- A one-page essay explaining your specific interests in anthropology and how those interests relate to your career goals.
- Major in anthropology.
- Minimum 3.0 GPA.

_____ Leslie and Leonard Lieberman Scholarship for Achievement in Anthropology, Sociology, Social Work, or Family Studies (Interdepartmental)

Requirements:

- A typewritten statement of your professional goals (1-2 pages, double-spaced).
- Major in anthropology, sociology, social work, or family studies.
- Junior or senior standing by Fall 2023 with a minimum 3.4 GPA.
- File FAFSA for 23-24 academic year.

_____ Study and Service Worldwide (SASW) Award (Interdepartmental)

Requirements:

- A one-page essay describing your international endeavor along with the other funding possibilities to which you have applied.
- Major in sociology, anthropology, or social work.
- Must use the award for engaging in coursework, field school, internship, practicum, research, conference presentation, service learning, or humanitarian service outside the United States.
- This award is not renewable and may be awarded only once to any individual student.
- File FAFSA for 23-24 academic year.

Philosophy Majors or Minor

_____ Fuller Endowed Scholarship

Requirements:

- A typewritten statement (not to exceed 500 words) reflecting your strong philosophical ability, motivation, and interest in studying philosophy.
- Must be a declared philosophy major or minor.
- Junior or senior status at the beginning of the Fall 2023 semester.
- Minimum 3.0 GPA overall and in philosophy for the previous year.

_____ Oppenheimer-Mancuso (Lazorshak) Award

Requirements:

- A typewritten essay (between 1500-2000 words) about the necessity for the teaching of ethics and/or character development in elementary grades.
- Senior status at the beginning of Fall 2023 semester.
- Must be a declared philosophy major or minor.
