## **2026 COHORT**

Application Deadline: March 1, 2024

\*Depending on the number of students admitted during the spring admission cycle, the admission process for the following fall admission cycle may be limited or suspended. Therefore, it is highly recommended that students apply in the spring.

Important: You are encouraged to submit application materials as early as possible. Staff in the social work office will retain and organize materials for admission review. Email confirmations are sent to the student when materials are received.

	Personal Interest Statement – use prompts provided in application
	Approval Form for Social Work Related Experience - Submit your approval form as soon as you have an experience identified.
End-of deadli	f-Semester Materials (submit by the end-of-semester ne):
	Two (2) Academic Reference Forms – Give your referees the form as soon as possible so they have time to return it by the deadline. These cannot be from a CMU social work instructor.
	Reference Form(s) for Social Work Related Experience documenting at least 50 hours of program approved paid or unpaid experience.
	Note: All BSW students are required to complete a minimum of 100 hours in not more than two (2) settings with at least 35 hours in the shorter experience. Any remaining hours must be completed by December of the year applied (before taking SWK 321 in the spring semester).

	sion Requirements (to be met when grades are posted for emester application is submitted):
	50 credit hours with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or above
	Minimum of 12 credits of major courses with a major GPA of 2.7 or better and no grade below a C in any required major course
	SWK 100 with a C or better
	SWK 205 with a B- or better (2023-2024 bulletin and later)
	SWK 250 with a B- or better
	Math Competency with a C or better
	Freshman English Competency with a C or better
	Oral English Competency with a C or better
