## Topic of the Month: Social Sustainability



#### What is Social Sustainability?

Sustainability as a whole is made up of several pillars united under the concept of meeting the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs. Social sustainability emphasizes maintaining a society through equity, equality, and community. Examples include protecting human health and access to basic resources, promoting education, and encouraging participation in efforts to be more sustainable.

#### Why is it Important?

Social sustainability is often overlooked in favor of environment and economy sustainability, but it is just as important. Social sustainability works to ensure that everyone is represented in processes that impact them and strives to prevent issues like inequality and inaccessibility that impact the overall goal of making the planet more viable.

#### How does CS Practice Social Sustainability?

CS practices social sustainability through community outreach and education. The team is also always open to suggestions and to support individuals with their own endeavors to make CMU more sustainable.
