CENTRAL MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR VENDORS PROVIDING SERVICES ON THE PREMISES

Vendors providing services on the premises of CMU must provide Certificates of Insurance evidencing the following coverages prior to admittance to the premises. The vendor is to procure and maintain the required insurance at their own expense.

- 1. Commercial General Liability insurance including premises and operations, product liability, completed operations liability, contractual liability and broad form property damage liability with minimum limits of \$1,000,000 each occurrence for bodily injury and property damage, \$2,000,000 aggregate.
- 2. Automobile liability for all trucks, trailers, or other motor vehicles owned, hired, operated or used by the Vendor on CMU premises with minimum limits of \$1,000,000 each occurrence for bodily injury and property damage.
- 3. Workers' Compensation for all of its full-time and part-time employees in accordance with the laws of the State of Michigan, including alternate employer endorsement and Employers' Liability with limits no less than \$1,000,000 per accident for bodily injury or disease.
- 4. Excess Liability (Umbrella) with \$1,000,000 limits.
- 5. Central Michigan University must be named as an additional insured on General Liability, Excess (Umbrella) and Automobile Liability policies. Insured versus Insured exclusion must be removed.
- 6. The Vendor may be required to provide higher limits and/or additional lines of insurance such as Educators Legal Liability/Professional Liability, Pollution Liability, Cyber Liability, etc. in accordance with the service provided. Certificate of Insurance must be reviewed and approved by Risk Management, Environmental Health & Safety.

The certificate must reflect the following detail to be acceptable:

- The certificate(s) must name Central Michigan University as the Certificate Holder.
- The certificate(s) must indicate Central Michigan University as an additional insured on commercial general liability and auto liability.
- The policy period is current for the dates indicated for the scheduled activity.
- In the description portion of the insurance certificate, the service type, contract number or project name need to be indicated.

• The cancellation portion of the certificate must state advance notice in accordance with the policy provisions.

• The Vendor agrees to forward immediately to the CMU Director of Risk Management, Environmental Health & Safety renewal certificates of insurance should any of the insurance coverage evidenced expire during the term of the contract.
