

What is Open Enrollment?

Open enrollment is the one time of year that you, as an employee, can make benefit changes without a qualified life event such as but not limited to:

- Add or remove your spouse or children
- Elect or change your current coverages
- Drop coverage all together

When is Open Enrollment held at CMU?

- All benefit eligible employees: April 14th April 25th at 5:00 pm
- Please note that for the all employees elections will take effect on July 1st
- Regular faculty: MESSA medical/prescription open enrollment is held in October with an effective date of January 1.

During this period, what can employees do?

- Review and elect benefits in CMU Choices.
- Explore health plans, coverage levels, and other benefits
- Make changes such as: Adjust current coverage, enroll in new plans, or elect their contributions for accounts like Flexible Spending Accounts (FSAs) or Health Savings Accounts (HSAs).

Is there any other option to make benefit changes?

Outside of open enrollment, changes to benefits are only allowed for qualifying status change events, such as marriage, birth of a child, or loss of coverage. Changes must be submitted to the Benefits & Wellness Office within 30 calendar days of the date of the status change event.
