<u>CODE OF STUDENT RIGHTS, RESPONSIBILITIES AND DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES:</u> <u>PROPOSED REVISIONS:</u> CONSENT AGENDA

BE IT RESOLVED, That the proposed revision to the Code of Student Rights, Responsibilities and Disciplinary Procedures is approved.

Code of Student Rights, Responsibilities and Disciplinary Procedures: Proposed Revisions

Currently reads as follows:

Section 3.2.12 Controlled Substances.

A student shall not possess, use, manufacture, produce, or distribute, or aid in the use, manufacture, production, or distribution of, any controlled substance except as expressively permitted by law and university policy. Violation of the Residence Life Alcohol and Controlled Substances Policy is a violation of this section. Controlled substances are defined in the Controlled Substances Act of 1971, as amended.

The use or abuse of prescription drugs or over the counter substances such as inhalants or herbals, in any way other that the intended or appropriate use, may be interpreted as a violation under this policy.

Proposed Change:

Section 3.2.12 Controlled Substances.

A student shall not possess, use, manufacture, produce, or distribute, or aid in the use, manufacture, production, or distribution of, any controlled substance except as expressively permitted by federal law and university policy. Possession, use, manufacture, production, or distribution of marijuana is strictly prohibited by federal law and university policy on university properties or at any university related event, regardless of state law. Federal Law, including the Drug Free Schools and Communities Act, prohibits marijuana on university properties or at any university related event.

Violation of the Residence Life Alcohol and Controlled Substances Policy is a violation of this section. Controlled substances are defined in the Controlled Substances Act of 1971, as amended.

The use or abuse of prescription drugs or over the counter substances such as inhalants or herbals, in any way other than the intended or appropriate use, may be interpreted as a violation under this policy.

A student agrees that if the student is in possession of marijuana, or any related or derivative marijuana product (product), the student will comply with the directive of a CMU employee, including in the residence

halls, to discard such product in accordance with the CMU employee's directive. If a student fails or refuses to comply with such directive, the student will be considered in violation of a Grave Offense (Section 4.4.14) under this Code, which carries the minimum mandatory sanction of suspension from the university.

4.4 Automatic Sanctions for Grave Offenses

ADD:

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4.4.14 Failure to comply with a university employee's directive to discard a marijuana product discovered in the student's possession.

RESIDENCE LIFE FACILITIES – INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS

Applicant will be a graduate student pursuing a choral conducting career in the Master of Music: Conducting or Music Education concentrations, or an undergraduate student with a signed Bachelor of Music Education: Choral Option major and has attained music candidacy. Undergraduate applicants must have earned an overall GPA of at least 3.0 and have at least one semester of experience as a registered student in the CMU Concert Choir and/or Chamber Singers. Applicants must provide an up-to-date CV; two letters of recommendation attesting to achievement and promise as a musician and an educator; and an essay [no more than 300 words] in which they describe their achievements as a choral education student and their aspirations as a choral educator.

Seybert Family Medical Study Abroad Experience

Established in 2018 by Phillip '75 and Kim Seybert. Income from the endowment will support one College of Medicine faculty member and up to five College of Medicine students. Preference will be given to 1) students who have expressed interest in family practice; and 2) originate from Gratiot, Isabella, Midland and Clare counties.
