SUBJECT: SERVICE AND SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON CAMPUS

The President of the university has the authority to develop and promulgate regulations to govern the use of alcoholic beverages on the university campus and in connection with University activities.

The Central Michigan University Board of Trustees authorizes the limited service and sale of alcoholic beverages on its campus in accordance with the law, and the president or vice president for business and finance is empowered to grant approval for a special license for the sale of beer, wine and/or spirits for consumption on the premises of the Central Michigan University campus as permitted by law.

This resolution supersedes the resolution adopted by the Board of Trustees, December 18, 1971 at 274.
