SUBJECT: STATUTORY LOYALTY OATH REQUIREMENT FOR ALL UNIVERSITY FACULTY MEMBERS

- Any educational institution, junior college, college or university which shall employ any such person in violation of the terms of this act shall, during the continuance of such unlawful employment
 - If such be an institution supported wholly or in part by state funds, not (a) receive any state moneys for any purpose whatsoever.
 - If such institution be a private, charitable and/or denominational college or university whose property, or any part thereto, is exempt from taxation, immediately forfeit all right to such tax exemption.
