SUBJECT: MASTERS DEGREE REQUIREMENT

Two Alternative Graduate Degree Plans Available

"While the completion of a thesis or field study is optional for the Master's degree, each student who completes his first graduate enrollment towards the Master's degree at Central Michigan University after July 1, 1967, must submit evidence beyond the completion of course work of his scholarship and/or creative or artistic ability. Two plans, differing to some degree in the various departments, are in general use. Subject to the approval of his major adviser, the student may elect either plan. Plan A consists of course work, a thesis, and an oral examination over the thesis and, at the discretion of the department, over the student's field of specialization. Plan B consists of course work, additional significant evidence of scholarship and/or creative or artistic ability and, at the discretion of the department, a comprehensive written examination over the field of specialization. It shall be the responsibility of the Department Chairman to notify the Graduate Office of the student's fulfillment of these requirements."
