**SUBJECT: POLITICAL SCIENCE CREDIT REQUIRED FOR ALL
 BACCALAUREATE DEGREES**

In all county normal schools a course of 4 term hours shall be given in civics, and in all colleges receiving public money, courses of no less than 3 semester hours, or equivalent, shall be given in political science, or in government and public administration, covering the form and functions of our federal and state governments, and of counties, cities and villages. Throughout said course the rights and responsibilities of citizenship shall be stressed. No baccalaureate degree or diploma shall be granted after June 30, 1958, to any student of such normal school or college unless such student shall have successfully completed said courses.
