SUBJECT: MULTICULTURAL ADVANCEMENT SCHOLARSHIP

The name of the minority advancement scholarship/grant is changed to the Multicultural Advancement Scholarship. The value is changed to \$4,125. The first paragraph in the description below is approved for printing:

Multicultural Advancement Scholarship

These awards recognize and support students who, through their past activities or educational aspirations, indicate an interest in the advancement of minorities in American society. These awards equal \$4,125 and are renewable up to three additional years for students who maintain a satisfactory academic record.

Selection Criteria

- 1. A desire to promote multicultural experiences and lifestyles on CMU's campus.
- 2. Enrollment in an undergraduate degree program at CMU.
- 3. A beginning freshman. (However, exceptions for upperclass persons may be authorized by the president.)
- 4. Registered as a full-time student (12 hours/semester).
- 5. Additionally, the selection committee will examine other factors intended to promote educational pluralism, which may include:
 - exceptional personal talent
 - appropriate work or service experience
 - leadership potential
 - maturity
 - history of overcoming disadvantages, ability to communicate with under-represented minority student groups.
