SUBJECT: CMU POLICE DEPARTMENT OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

- A. There is created a CMU Police Department Oversight Committee, which shall be comprised of individuals nominated and elected individuals shall include: two (2) students; two (2) members of the faculty; and two (2) members of the university staff who are neither members of the faculty nor police officers. The Oversight Committee shall receive and address grievances by persons against the CMU police department or CMU police officers and may make recommendations to the CMU police chief that disciplinary measures be taken against any CMU police officer who is found responsible for misconduct in office.
- B. The president is authorized further specify the charge to this Oversight Committee, established or approve its operating procedures, and establish or approve the methods for election of its members, in a manner consistent with Act No. 120, Public Acts of 1990, being MCLA 390.1511, and this resolution.
- C. The president shall provide the Board of Trustees with a copy of each executive memorandum issued pursuant to the authority conferred herein, at the time that such memorandum is issued.
