



## *Junior Year Protocol*

Another year has been completed and you are going strong. This is the year you are able to move off campus if you wish, while continuing to positively affect your surrounding community.

Your Junior Year Protocol can be found below:

1. **Lloyd M. Cofer and Multicultural Advancement-** Scholars must earn at least 24 new undergraduate credits per academic year (12 per semester) and maintain a cumulative annual grade point average of 2.5.
2. **Multicultural Award of Distinction-** Scholars must earn at least 30 new undergraduate credits per academic year (15 per semester) and maintain a cumulative annual grade point average of 3.25.
3. **Attend the assigned number of cultural events per programming month-** Hispanic Heritage Month, Native American Heritage Month, Black History Month, Asian Pacific American Heritage Month, Martin Luther King, Jr. Week, and Middle Eastern Heritage Week.
4. **Attend MAC Scholars Meetings-** During the Fall and Spring semesters, the scholars will meet for a one hour meeting with the scholarship coordinator.
5. **Attend 'Life After College' program-** Offices from around campus will gather to discuss the transition from college to career life.
6. **Multicultural Education-** Scholars are required to complete SOC 302 during this academic year and have scheduled the last three credit course in order to complete this requirement. Distinction Scholars must earn a B- or better in this course. Cofer and Advancement Scholars must earn a C or better in this course.
7. **4- Year Plan Review-** During the Fall semester you will need to schedule an appointment with the scholarship coordinator (or their designee) to review the progress on your 4-year plan.
