Objective

To integrate career and professional development within a student's experirence and demonstrate requisite core competenices that broadly prepare students for success in the workplace and lifelong career management.

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Learning Goals

Critical Thinking

- Identify a campus issue and present potential solutions to the Student Government Association
- Complete a career assessment (Focus 2 Career, Myers Briggs-Type Indicator, or Strong Interest Inventory) and schedule an appointment with the Career Development Center to discuss your results

Communication

- Complete a mock interview with the Career Development Center
- Finalize your self-narrative (present an elevator pitch to class, have your resume or cover letter reviewed, update your LinkedIn profile, etc.)

Teamwork

- Get involved with a student organization on campus
- Complete a group project for a class

Technology

- Identify a technology that is useful in your chosen career field and complete a training or course to build your skills
- Produce a video to highlight the work of a student organization

Leadership

- Participate in a leadership training program offered by the Sarah R. Opperman Leadership Institute
- Seek a formal or informal leadership role in a student organization
