## Summary

The following table shows the status of students who graduated with an undergraduate degree from Central Michigan University between August of 2023 and June of 2024. The results of this table were found using three different avenues of research. These avenues included surveys conducted by the university (e.g., the First Destination Survey), a query to the National Student Clearinghouse (which maintains a listing of educational data), and through social media investigation (e.g., LinkedIn). Of the 2,317 graduating students, there were 1,841 students whose status was found using the survey, query, or social media for a knowledge rate of 79.5%. The status breakdown by source can be seen in the following table:

The information contained in the following document summarizes the data collected from undergraduate students who graduated from Central Michigan University between June 2023 and August of 2024. These groups constitute a total of 2,317 graduates. Of these graduates, 362 (15.6%) completed employment questions on the Graduating Student Exit Survey only and 272 (11.7%) completed the First Destination Survey, resulting in a response rate of 27.4%. The respondents had a higher GPA than the nonrespondents in the graduating population (3.42 vs. 3.37) and consisted of more females (71% vs. 62%). Based on the results of the surveys, 72% of respondents were employed six months after graduating from CMU, while an additional 10% chose to continue their education.
