GRE Subject Tests

If your grad school interests are rooted in math, literature, or a specific area of science, you may need to take a GRE Subject Test (either independently, or in addition to the General Test).

Test areas include

-Biochemistry
-Cell and Molecular Biology
-Biology
-Chemistry
-Computer Science
-Literature in English
-Mathematics
-Physics
-Psychology

Unlike the General Test, the GRE Subject Tests can only be taken in October, November, and April. Students are advised to register at least 1 month in advance.

-Subject tests can last up to 3 ½ hours

-Arrive on time, with valid ID and several number 2 pencils

-Once registered, you'll receive a practice test and study guide

-Purchase study guides or review your college textbooks

-GRE Subject Tests are quite rigorous. Don't waste your time and money if you're not well-prepared, or if your first choice grad schools don't require these scores.
