SEM HRS = Semester hours earned.

CUM TOT = Total cumulative hours earned, including transfer credit hours.

GPA HR = Any credit hours that affect a student's grade point average, which would be any credit hours where a student

earns a grade of A through E.

**POINTS** = Total honor points earned.

= Determined by dividing the honor points by the GPA hours.

For GRADUATE students, undergraduate courses (Numbered less than 500) do not count in GPA hours or total hours.

#### **CREDIT/NO CREDIT SYSTEM**

Effective Fall 2004, an undergraduate grade of CR means the student earned a grade of C or better, prior to Fall 2004 a C- or better. For Graduates a grade of CR means the student performed at or above the level required for graduation (3.0 or B). Prior to Fall 1989, a course with a grade of NC did not appear on the undergraduate record. CR grades are figured only in the total hours earned portion of the cumulative grade point average.
