- Courses appearing in RED with IP for the grade means they are courses still in progress or we haven't received an official transcript with those grades to officially process them. Request to have your official transcript sent to apply@cmich.edu once grades have been posted to your academic history at that school.
- If you see **NO CRED** under CMU Course, this means the course has been evaluated and was determined not to transfer. Why would it not transfer? Generally, this means the coursework is not germane to courses offered at CMU or it is considered a developmental course. Courses that are not germane means we have no equivalent course to match it you.
- If you see **GEO CRED** under CMU Course, this means you received department credit because there is not an exact CMU course match. If it is a science course and your course doesn't include a lab, but our course does, you will only receive departmental credit. This course could be used as a general elective or possibly a course on your program of study. **If you feel this course should be a direct equivalent, you can provide the course syllabi and we will ask the department chairperson to review the course.** Send syllabi to transfercredit@cmich.edu
- If you see a notation under the **UP** column, this means this course satisfies one of our University Program-General Education requirements. In the example above, MTH 132 satisfies Group IIB of our University Program requirements.
- If you see a notation under the **Comp** column, this means this particular course satisfies one of our Competency-General Education requirements. In the example above, COM 357 satisfies our Oral English Competency.
