The U.S. Department of Education (Department) announced on April 6, 2022, that it would eliminate the negative effects of default for borrowers who defaulted on their federal student loans prior to the pandemic payment pause. Among other features, this initiative, called "Fresh Start," will enable borrowers with defaulted federal student loans to regain <i>Title IV HEA</i> federal student aid eligibility, including Federal Pell Grants and campus-based aid like Federal Work-Study. This Fresh Start initiative will remain available to previously defaulted borrowers with eligible loans, for one year after the end of the COVID-19 pandemic student loan payment pause.
